Environmental Responsibility

We gradually replace equipment with greener technologies and practices. For example, when purchasing new printers, we prioritize the most energy- and resource-efficient ones.

We measure and monitor energy and water consumption with the goal of reducing their use.

We support conservation initiatives such as marine protection, reforestation, and wildlife preservation. Through our partnership with Tree-Nation, we plant trees and monitor our CO₂ offsets as part of our goal to be a carbon-neutral company.

We offset carbon emissions through local environmental programs whenever possible.

We do not promote souvenirs containing endangered species of flora or fauna.

We maintain a strong ethical stance regarding animals:

We do not offer experiences that involve touching or feeding wild animals, nor tours that include captive animals, marine mammals, animal shows, or any form of cruelty.

Wildlife and indigenous experiences in the Philippines are carefully managed, based solely on non-intrusive observation practices.

We prioritize local businesses, guides, and artisans so that tourism directly benefits Philippine communities.

We support fair wages, safe working conditions, and offer training for office and field staff, fostering professional development.

We design experiences that foster respectful and meaningful connections with rural and indigenous communities.

We promote authentic, ethical, and educational cultural interactions, actively protecting the tangible and intangible heritage of the Philippines.

Traveler Education

We educate travelers on responsible behavior: avoiding illegal souvenirs, practicing reef-safe practices, respecting local customs, and reducing plastic use.

We encourage support for local services, respect for wildlife, and protection of cultural integrity. Each traveler receives clear sustainability guidelines, emergency contacts, and our Code of Conduct.
